CHIEF JUSTICE AND ASHOK S.KINAGI	WP 7483/2020	19/10/2020	<p>Sri M.N.Kumar, the learned CGC appearing for the Government of India again seeks time to file the statement of objections.</p> <p>Sri Colin Gonsalves, the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner pointed out that time has been granted to the Government of India by way of a last chance by the order dated 5th October 2020.</p> <p>As noted in one of the earlier orders, only second and third prayer clauses for interim relief in the amended petition have been pressed into service.</p> <p>Though the order dated 5th October 2020 records that time is granted to the Government of India as a last chance, during the period of pandemic, we will have to adopt a liberal approach. However, till the matter is heard for consideration of prayer for interim relief, we must clarify that in the absence of any legislation, neither the State Government nor the Central Government or its agencies or instrumentalities can deny any benefit to a citizen only on the ground that he has not installed the Arogya Sethu application on his cell phone.</p> <p>List this petition on 10th November 2020 for hearing on the prayers for interim relief.</p> <p>Only by way of an indulgence, time granted to file objections to the Government of India is extended till 3rd November, 2020.</p>
