<b>CHIEF JUSTICE AND ASHOK S.KINAGI</b>	<b>WP 7483/2020</b>	<b>19/08/2020</b>	<p>Considering the issues which are raised in this petition, we issue rule nisi.</p> <p>The learned counsel appearing for the respondents today waive notice.</p> <p>The prayer for interim relief in terms of prayer clause (2) of the petition will have to be considered. For hearing the parties on prayer clause (2), the petition shall be listed on 3rd September, 2020.</p> <p>The learned counsel appearing for the Airports Authority of India states that the earlier guidelines have been modified and revised guidelines issued by the Airports Authority of India make it very clear that downloading of Aarogya Setu app for air travelers is not mandatory and it is optional. We accept the said statement.</p> <p>If for dealing with the prayer for interim relief any of the respondents desire to file statement of objections, the same shall be filed on or before 1st September, 2020.</p> <p>The soft copies of the statement of objections, if any, filed shall be supplied to the learned counsel for the parties.</p> <p><b>ORDER ON I.A.NO.3/2020</b></p> <p>Heard learned counsel appearing for the applicant. His submission is that 14 crore citizens are using Aarogya Setu app and it is really useful as stated in paragraph No.4 of the intervention application.</p> <p>In this petition, this Court is not concerned with the question whether the Aarogya Setu app is good or bad or the nature and extent of services which are available by virtue of Aarogya Setu App. The issue at this stage when we are hearing the prayer for interim relief is whether the State or its agencies and/or its instrumentalities can make downloading of Aarogya Setu app as a condition precedent to enable the citizens to avail the services or privileges to which they are entitled to from the State or from its agencies and/or the instrumentalities. Therefore, no case is made out for permitting intervention of the applicant. The application is accordingly disposed of.</p>
