**Subject: Updating the patient COVID-19 testing guidelines dated 25.07.2020.**

We write this mail to thank you for clarifying that Aadhaar card is not mandatory for RT-PCR mobile application during sample collection for COVID-19.

We request you to kindly update the guidelines dated 25.07.2020 and state that “any government identification can be used for COVID-19 testing”. We see that these amendments are not reflected in the guidelines for RT-PCR mobile application used during the sample collection for COVID-19 testing. This still is in contravention of the Puttaswamy judgment (2019).

We sincerely hope that the Government of Rajasthan will take this into account and amend the guidelines accordingly.
